#### Sanction


- The swim was sanctioned by the World Open Water Swimming Association (WOWSA) and the Marathon Swimmers Federation (MSF).




### Conditions: Weather etc.

- Water and air temperatures
  - 7:23 pm (Jul 25): Started at 19.6°C and 17.8°C respectively.
  - Air temperature ranged from 15.3°C to 19.6°C during the swim.
  - Water temperature dropped to 17.5°C across Baie Verte.
  - Water temperature ranged between 16.4°C and 18.0°C throughout the swim.
  - 4:00 am (Jul 26): Water temperature at a Low of 16-17°C as they passed Cape Tormentine.
  - 12:02 pm (Jul 26): Water temperature of 16.4°C at the finish.
  - 9:00 pm (Jul 25): Wind peaked at 4-6 knots with 15-20 cm waves.
  - Winds across the main channel were fairly consistent from the south at 10 knots.
- White caps on waves and fog for most of the morning of July 26<sup>th</sup>.
- Tides at Borden:
  - 6:40 pm, 25<sup>th</sup> July, High
  - 11:50 pm, 25<sup>th</sup> July, Low
  - 6:00 am, 26<sup>th</sup> July, High
  - 1:20 pm, 26<sup>th</sup> July, Low
  - 3 days after first-quarter moon.
- Marilyn received numerous jellyfish stings during the first stage of the swim across Baie Verte. After the swim, she reported "I got 22 stings on my face and 3 or 4 dozen on each extremity. Fortunately they stopped hurting after 10-15 minutes."

## **Other Details**

- Time-stamped positional details were recorded (Nominally every 10 minutes) via a SPOT Tracker and/or by hand-held GPS.
- Food and drinks included: Carbo Pro, Perpetueum, Boost, Vega, Powerade, Jellytots, Yogi Ginger Tea, Organic Ginger Tea, Tetley Tea, Black, Earl Grey Tea, and Carnation Hot Chocolate.
- Feeding was nominally every 45 minutes.
- Marilyn used a mixture of 35% Vaseline and 65% Lanoline (Wool fat).
